

SAEEC Code of Conduct

I undertake to adhere and to take note of the **Southern African Energy Efficiency Confederation (SAEEC) CODE OF ETHICS**

The SAEEC members, to uphold and advance the honour and dignity of the energy profession and in keeping with high standards of ethical conduct:

- Will be honest and impartial, and will serve with devotion employers, clients, and the public.
 - Will strive to increase the competence and prestige of the profession.
 - Will use his or her knowledge and skill for the advancement of human welfare.
1. The SAE member will be guided in all professional relations by the highest standards of integrity and will act in professional matters for each client or employer as a faithful agent or trustee.
 2. The SAE member will have proper regard for the safety, health, and welfare of the public in the performance of professional duties.
 3. The SAE member will avoid all conduct or practice likely to discredit the profession or deceive the public.
 4. The SAE member will endeavour to extend public knowledge and appreciation of engineering and its achievements and to protect the profession from misrepresentation and misunderstanding.
 5. The SAE member will express an opinion of an engineering subject only when founded on adequate knowledge and honest conviction.
 6. The SAE member will not disclose confidential information concerning the business affairs or technical processes of any present or former client or employer without consent.
 7. The SAE member will endeavour to avoid conflicts of interest with his employer or client, but when unavoidable, he or she shall fully disclose the circumstances to employer or client.
 8. The SAE member will uphold the principle of appropriate and adequate compensation for those engaged in engineering work.
 9. The SAE member will cooperate in extending the effectiveness of the profession by interchanging information and experience with other engineers and students and will endeavour to provide opportunity for the professional development and advancement of engineers under his supervision.
